Walking and Cycling

Car Sharing

There are over 38 million empty seats on the UK roads every day. Why not make the most of it by sharing lifts? Halve your fuel costs, form new friendships and reduce the wear and tear on your car. Many employers are now recognising the importance of car sharing; find out more about the benefits your employer offers. Remember, car sharing can also be an informal arrangement with friends.

Remote Working

Reducing the need to travel either to work or while at work can save time, money and has positive environmental benefits. Even working from home once a fortnight reduces an employee's commuting time by 10 per cent, saves office space and allows 'hot-desking'. Remote and flexible working allows you to balance your work and home life commitments.

Public Transport

Using public transport helps to reduce congestion and carbon emissions. Substituting a car journey for one by bus once a week will help to alleviate congestion and parking pressure. Consider purchasing an advance ticket or ask about your company's salary sacrifice scheme to help reduce your travel costs.

After all, if every car commuter used an alternative to the car on just one day of the week, car usage levels for commuting would be reduced by 20 per cent with immediate effect.

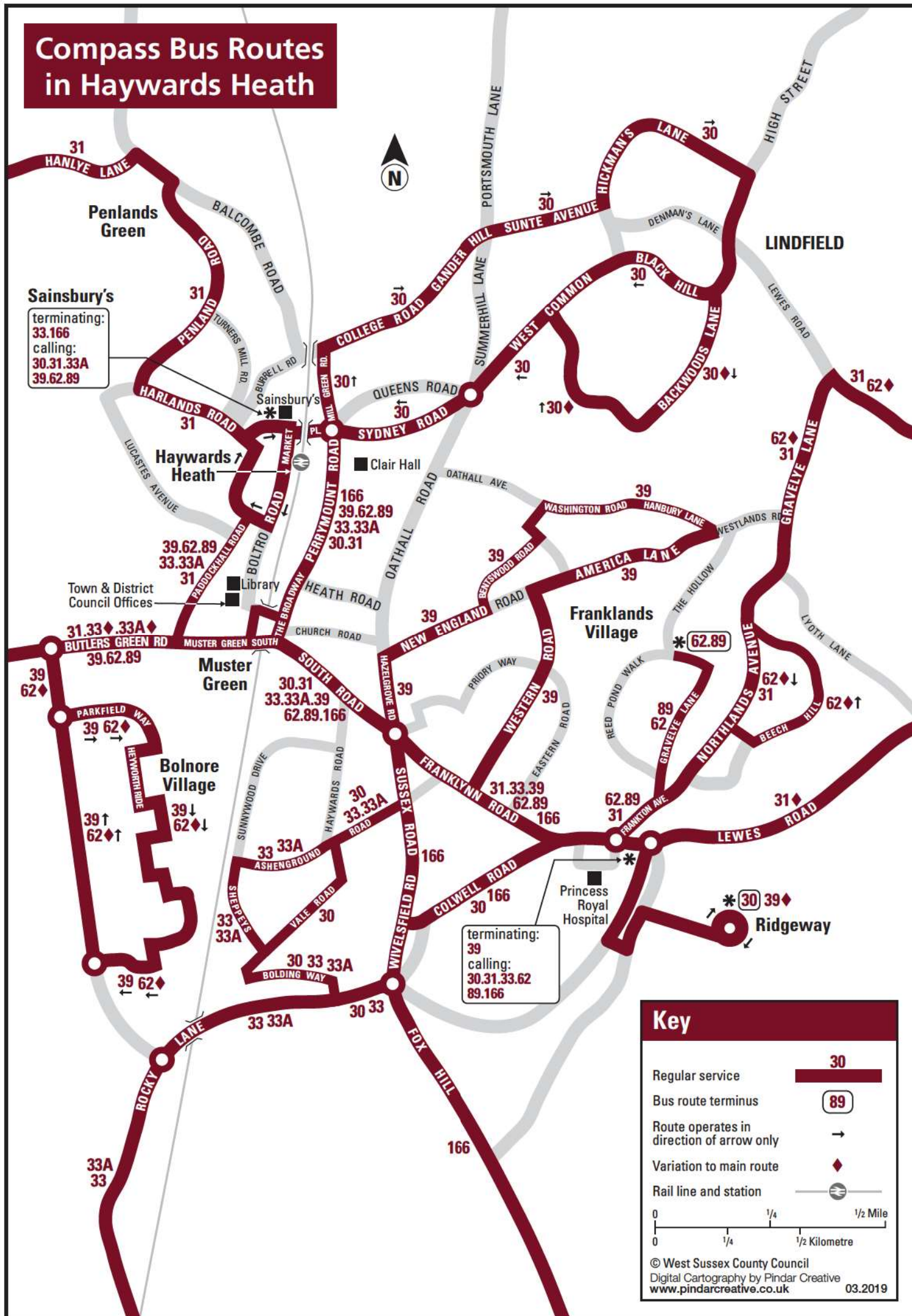

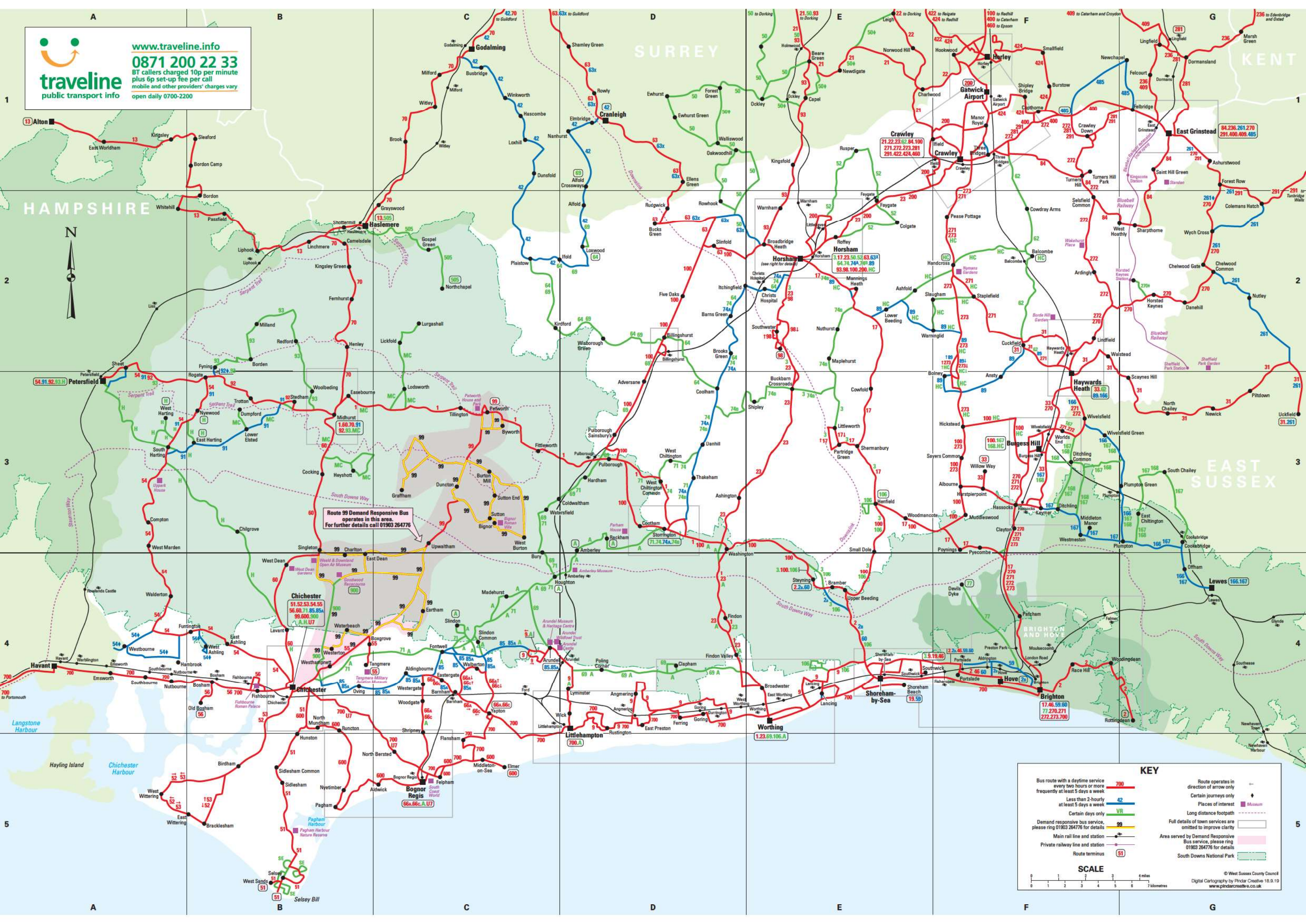

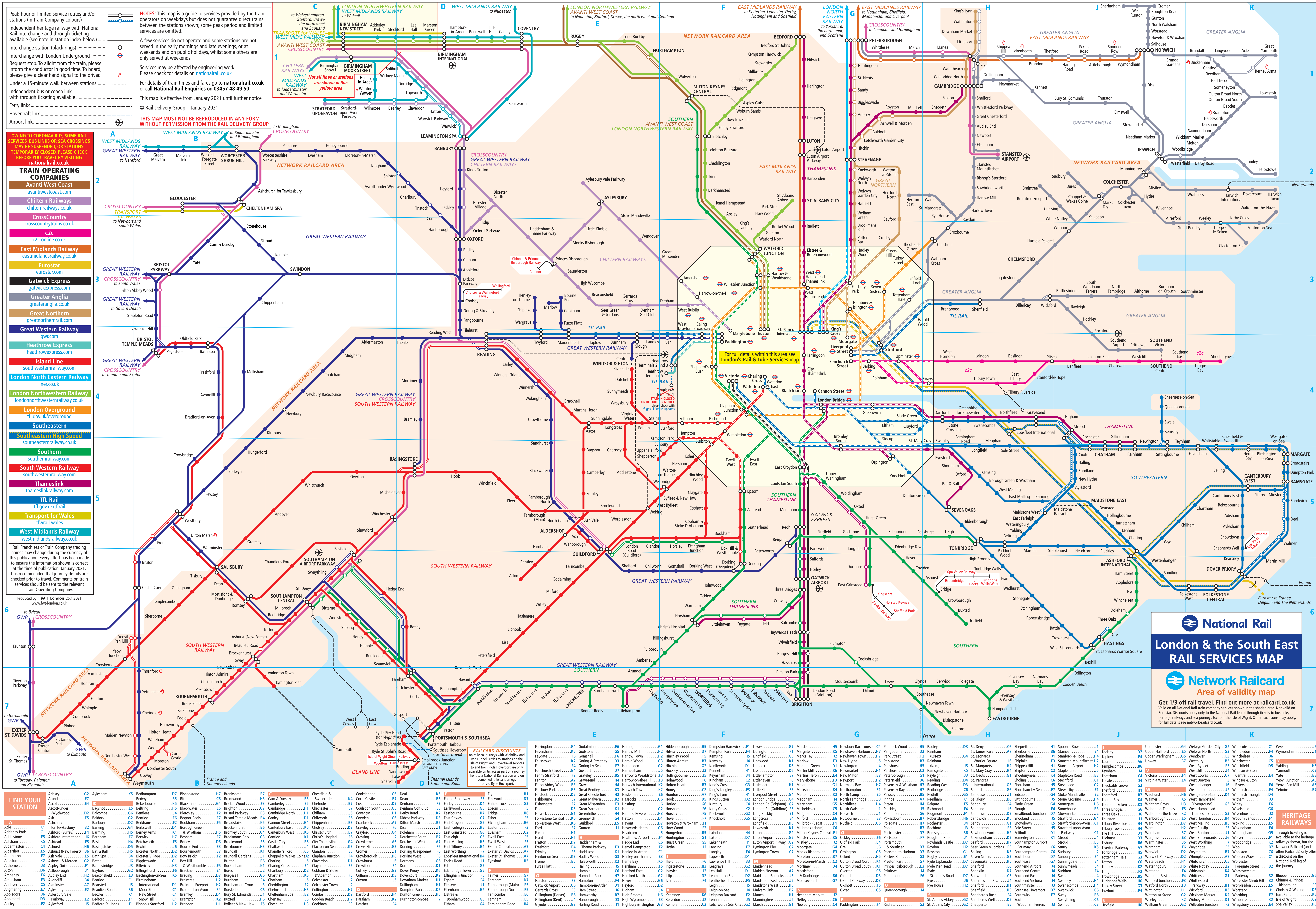
South Downs National Park

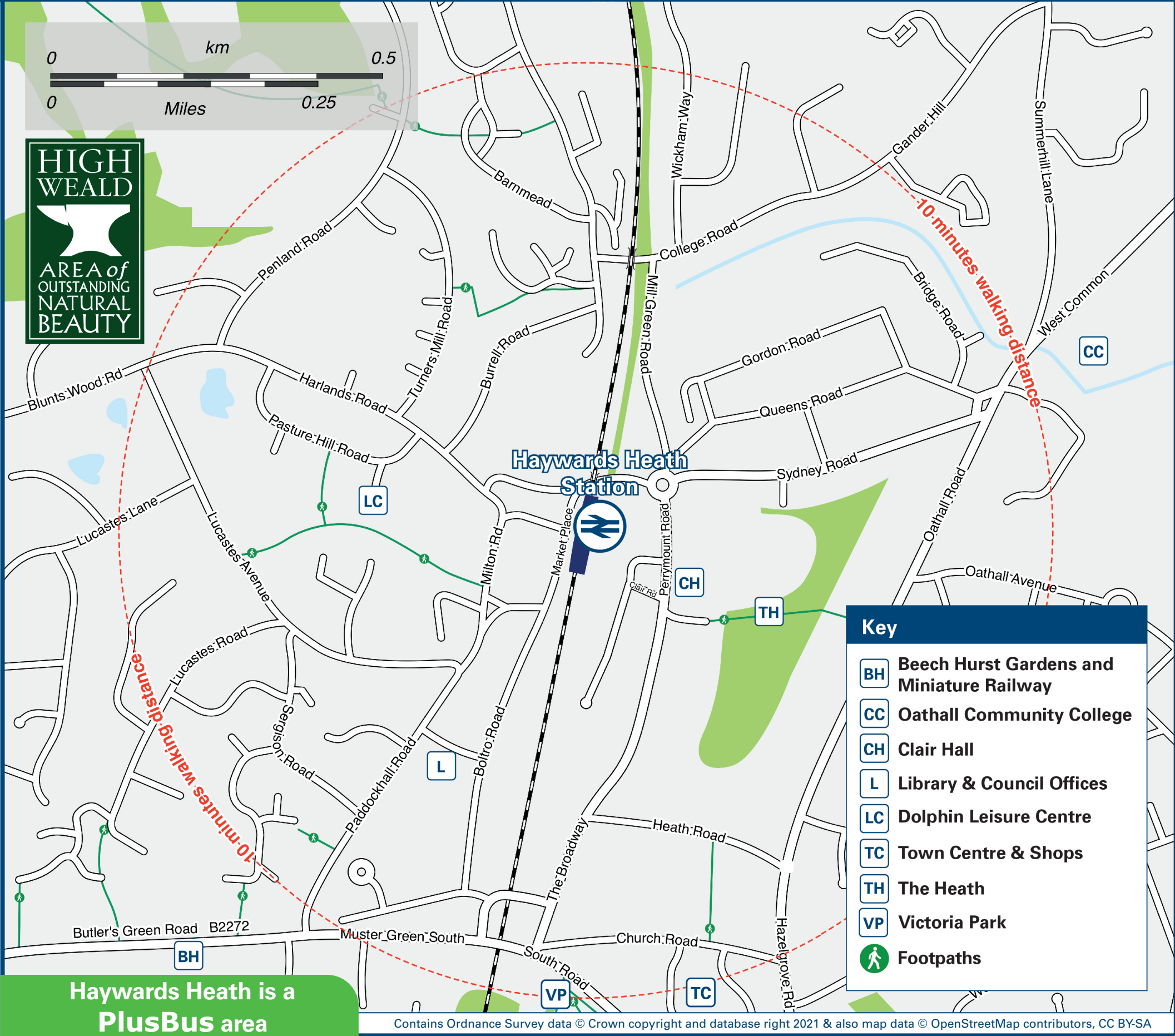
