Kids can't even get into the local school now. Where are they going to go when Copthorne , Turners Hill & Felbridge schools can't take them due to the excessive new builds in this area.

The doctors surgery is struggling to cope with the existing numbers of patients.

Getting a dentist is near impossible for some people. The roads are in the worse state I've ever seen them & I've been driving 37 years with the pot holes galore- how are they going to cope with all of this excess traffic. Plus it will be a nightmare getting in & out of the village.

I really feel for all these elderly residents who would like their nice quiet close left exactly as it is.

There must be other accesses to this development if it must go ahead. Please, please reconsider.
