- > Hi, I have been a resident of Bolney for last thirty eight years and have witnessed some appalling development already in the village. Bolney is a pleasant quiet place to live but does not need any more housing.
- > The proposed addition of another 200 plus houses to be built on Foxhole Farm must not go ahead. The streets in the village are narrow and cannot tolerate in influx of additional vehicle usage, let alone parking. There are no facilities such as Doctors surgery or shop.
- > The road , the A272, is already an inadequate main road with traffic jams , delays and worse still serious accidents every week especially at the Sussex Junction corner.
- > If the 200 plus house development goes ahead it must surely be realised that each house will need two working residents to possibly pay a mortgage and so on. This means also at least two cars or vehicles per household. In turn this means 400 cars trying to exit on to the A272 every day between 8 am and 9 am and returning between 5 pm and 6 pm EVERY day! The traffic jams, anger and frustration of drivers would cause chaos ,not to mention serious accidents all the way from Cowfold to Ansty. Yes 400 additional vehicles! This means ongoing delays for every resident of Bolney as it is already! This must surely be an undeniable possibility.

- > Bolney had just had and has had water supply problems to households. This has not been addressed at all !
