We wish to have our opposition recorded regarding the application for the proposed development via Woodlands Close or by any other other access. The proposed new road layout would be completely inappropriate, isolating one bungalow that would become a property on what potentially would be a 'roundabout' and causing huge distress to the other residents of Woodland Close.

Crawley Down has seen a massive amount of new developments over the past few years and having lived in the village for 35 years and, admittedly, having downsized to a new house in a small Close of just 9 houses, we are now living already in a small 'town' with no 'town' facilities, so to add this development, together with the Wates development off the Turners Hill Road is just too much for our 'village' infrastructure to cope with.
