I refer to your email which I have been forwarded as a representation for the current planning application under DM/25/1800, which relates to part of the garden at Woodside Grange. I have reviewed the submitted Location and Site Plans and I cannot locate the right of way that you state is 'indicated on the map as K11'.

The proposed vehicular access route for the proposed two houses is marked with a red outline on the submitted plans. This is via the existing track which extends to the site in a westerly direction off Ockley Lane, not from Woodlands Road.


