I wish to log a formal objection to the development proposals for DM/25/0015, 25/0014, 25/0016 and 25/0017 in Crawley Down.

Apart from the usual objections I'm sure you are receiving from all around, regarding the expansion of our once tiny village into what I now class as almost a small town with virtually no amenities for over 5000 residence, this proposal is inexplicably proposing a junction on to Turners hill Road at an already very dangerous corner. Currently Vicarage road comes out onto turners hill Road just below Grange road, both roads struggling to see around a railway bridge which crosses the worth way. Turners hill Road is extremely busy now, especially 7-9am and 1600-1800 and you literally take your life in your hands trying to safely pull out of either junction. To add another junction here beggars belief and I cannot believe it is even on the proposal. You will create another Turners Hill cross roads, one of the most accident prone junctions in the county.

If this many house are being added to the area, another access point must be found.

I feel as do many residents, that our points of view are constantly ignored and overlooked by whoever keeps granting these planning permissions , but if this development goes ahead much to our objections another access point must be found for the safety of drivers and pedestrians alike.

Please come and drive the junction yourselves so you can see what I've said.
