Comments:	<p>I object to this development proposal for the following reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The proposal does not comply with relevant development policies. Firstly, the development will not enhance the current setting (DP15). Secondly, the development is outside of any built up area (DP16). Finally, the proposed design is not executed well and therefore does not add or preserve the character of the local area (DP26).

- This latest proposal needs to be viewed in light of the long planning history for the site. There has been numerous proposals for residential dwellings, change of use etc. that have all been refused and/or dismissed at appeal (DM/16/4406 and DM/17/4326). I do not see a clear need or reason for the conversion set out in the application.

- The site has been deliberately neglected and misused over the years. An applicant should not be rewarded approval of this kind as a means of cleaning up the site. This should not be considered a valid argument as stated in their application.
