Comments:	Whilst I am not against the building of houses per se, we need more homes, I am concerned that the volume of houses proposed for this site will add to the increasing volume within Sayers Common without the necessary and related infrastructure: school places, doctors appointments etc. With already inadequate public transport to nearby towns and supermarkets this will put further pressure on car use unless public transport is significantly improved for the village. Finally, I am concerned that this will lead to flooding, already of concern in the village. During the heavy rain last week, the B2118 was flooded again near the entrance to Wintergreen Way and water flows rapidly down our road when there is heavy rain. Wintergreen Way is directly opposite the proposed development
