

Re: Planning Application DM/25/1129 Land at Foxhole Farm


I am writing as a relative of a resident of Bolney, to express my strong objection to the Foxhole planning application.

The proposed development is not sustainable. Bolney is a small village with very limited services and infrastructure. They do not have a Post Office, grocery shop, GP surgery, dentist or a regular bus service and currently already have to use a car to access these services elsewhere.

This huge development is disproportionate to Bolney's current village size, in fact doubling the size of the main village! It will put an enormous strain on education provision and on an already stretched GP, dental and social care service. The local primary school is already at almost full capacity and it does not have the space for further expansion to the degree needed. Where will all these new families children go to school? They will have to drive them further afield causing more traffic on the local roads! There are no cycle paths to nearby villages and the A272 is a fast and busy road not suitable for cyclists. Having grown up in Bolney I am acutely aware of the limited facilities. I often travel to Bolney to visit family and am aware of the already very busy A272, which will only be made worse by the addition of 200 houses and related cars.

When visiting the village I enjoy local walks in the countryside. The development will detrimentally impact the village's character and have an adverse environmental impact too.
