Comments:	We strongly object to this latest planned development in or next to Anscombe Wood, for the following reasons. Although the plan appears to be a little lower, the two buildings between them cover just as much ground. They will collectively block the important wildlife corridor. The wildlife corridor essentially kept as a condition to the development to the south of the site. This cannot and should not be allowed to happen. The car parking arrangements are still more or less the same as last time and could result in the loss of important trees, and cars parking all over the buffer Zone with resulting damage to the preservation area of Anscombe wood. There is currently no information on where services will enter and leave the site, these being water, power, sewage and drainage. These could and will cause considerable disruption to the area.
