


# Socio-Economic Benefits of Development at Land west of Turners Hill Road and south of Huntslands, Crawley Down



This infographic provides an overview of the socio-economic benefits that could be delivered from the development of land at Crawley Down (south of Huntslands). The proposal includes a new sustainable development of 200 homes, which will make a significant contribution towards meeting a range of local housing needs, including family homes and 30% affordable housing. It includes new open space and associated play facilities. A new community orchard, as well as active travel opportunities, will encourage healthy lifestyles.

Overall, the delivery of new housing will provide benefits for the local economy during the construction period and further benefits for the community once occupied, which are captured and summarised here (n.b. figures are approximate and rounded).
