Good Morning Stefan,

Thank you for consulting NatureSpace on the above planning application. We are satisfied that if this development were to go ahead it would be unlikely to have an impact on great crested newts or their habitats.

There are 2 isolated ponds within 250m of the site with the closest being 108m away. The on-site habitat appears to be within the vegetated garden of the adjacent dwelling and unsuitable for great crested newts. Therefore, it is considered very unlikely that this development will have any impacts and disproportionate to request further information from the applicant in relation to great crested newts.

We therefore have no further comments to make at this time. If the proposal changes, then please seek further advice from us if necessary.
