As a resident I object to the proposal to build 48 to 50 new houses via Woodlands Close on the green fields.

The population in Crawley Down Village at circa 5,000 is already far too big for our village and all services are badly over stretched.

The GP surgery is totally unable to cope with demand, the pharmacy is already overwhelmed, the grocery store (Co-op) is very small and cramped, no pub, and the school is full. How on earth can anyone seriously believe that it is viable to build yet more homes in and immediately around the village centre?

In addition we have frequent power outages, low water pressure, and creaking infrastructure.
