Morning Katherine, thanks for these additional details.

The Stage One RSA issue was resolved directly between the Applicant's transport consultant and myself back in September. This point is therefore complete.

With the bridge, a 1.2 metre brick parapet would appear to comply with relevant design standards in terms of height so this in principle is accepted. Whilst more a matter of detail perhaps, it's not clear if there is to be any setback between the carriageway edge and the brick wall; I presume there will be but it's not immediately apparent. For the purposes of the current planning application, the details are fine but a margin will be required if the road and bridge are offered for adoption as public highway.

From a WSCC Highways point of view, there are no other outstanding issues. No objection would consequently be raised.

Those conditions included within the WSCC Highways response dated 8th August 2025 remain applicable. No further conditions are recommended.
