

Objections to the proposed development of Foxhole Farm

I think that 200 homes is far to many, it would turn a picturesque village like Bolney in to a small town without any of the facilities required to run it.

My major objection is because we have no doctors surgery or dentists or pharmacies within easy reach, or come to that any supermarkets, everyone would have to use their car and that would increase pressure on our country roads and at the A23/A272 junction at Bolney.

Our bus service is very poor and inadequate so again you can't get to a station or in town (Haywards Heath or Burgess Hill) without careful planning, or without using our cars in some way.

With 200 extra homes that would mean at least about 400 extra cars and possibly more adding their children.

Also again added pressure would be put on our small school for places, traffic to and from the school would bound to increase during morning and late afternoon times.

Another problem would be the increased extra pressure on our water and sewerage systems and also our power networks. which the village have had problems in the past when we have had bad weather.

Foxhole Lane is a lovely walk on our doorstep, and over the years we have lived here we have noticed the decline in the wild life butterflies, birds, insects etc. the thought of it being covered like one big housing estate is very worrying.

Allotments I think are not needed we have lived here for 40 plus years and not heard one person say we need any allotments.

Also we have already got a village hall and I don't think we need another which will have to be funded run and maintenance by someone from the village.
