I live in village and use Burleigh lane or acorn avenue daily to access the fields to walk my dog, whilst this proposal should have no impact, the proposal lacks sufficient parking for residents and visitors which will naturally spill into surrounding streets.

However, the surrounding streets are currently so full with parked cars from the two developments already developed with insufficient parking that they may as well now be considered single lanes, this includes woodlands close, hazel way, kiln road and Burleigh way. Traffic and pedestrian issues have naturally resulted, particularly on these roads. The additional volume of construction traffic required to develop this proposal at scale would mean the entire village would be gridlocked for the duration of the build and if approved the new residents will increase the parking issues.
