Good morning, Joanne,

Twineham Parish Council notes the planning application for 200 dwellings at Foxhole Farm, Bolney. Twineham Parish Council has serious concerns regarding the proposed access on to the A272. It is already extremely difficult for vehicle users to turn right from Bolney Chapel Road at this junction. There are frequent "shunts" along this stretch of the A272. The proposed access is almost opposite the garage on the south side of the A272, where there are frequent queues for petrol spilling back on to the A272. The proposed access will be a serious hazard and needs some serious reconsideration.

In view of the above concerns Twineham Parish Council requests a full road audit plan with proposed junction improvements.
