As a new resident in the Wychwood green development I would like to raise my concerns over the proposed use of the roads in and out of the Wychwood Place estate, for the potential new Wates development.

Put simply the road is not suitable to cope with the potential increase in traffic due to the width and nature of the road itself. Just turning into Wychwood Place from off of Turners Hill road can be extremely hazardous, especially if there is also another vehicle exiting. I dread to think what the potential chaos would be during times of peak travel in the morning and in the evening, with more than triple the amount of cars, let alone the additional volume of traffic caused by visitors and staff of the proposed new care home, all looking to exit and enter via the Wychwood estate.
