I am objecting to the proposed 48/50 dwellings off Woodlands Close due to the plan to demolish a pair of well-maintained semidetached houses to make an entrance to the site. This would result in the now detached bungalow being isolated between four roads and cause traffic chaos for the residents living nearby.

There was an entrance made a few years ago for 50 dwellings by demolishing the semidetached bungalow, at the end is a T junction with a road, Sycamore Lane, leading towards the new proposed development which seems to be the logical entrance to the proposed dwellings. It was always assumed the other half of the field would be developed at some time.

Several years ago, there was a proposal to build 200 houses on the land behind Hazel Way which was rejected. However, this is happening stealthily by building a few houses at a time.
