The tree report only seems to consider trees on the main site owned by the applicant, but I notice that the plans show some off-site hornbeams. These are not mentioned anywhere within the tree survey nor on the Tree Report Method Statement. The plans suggest that the proposal will be against the border , where these trees are situated.

Please could you request that the report is updated to consider these trees, too, please?
