

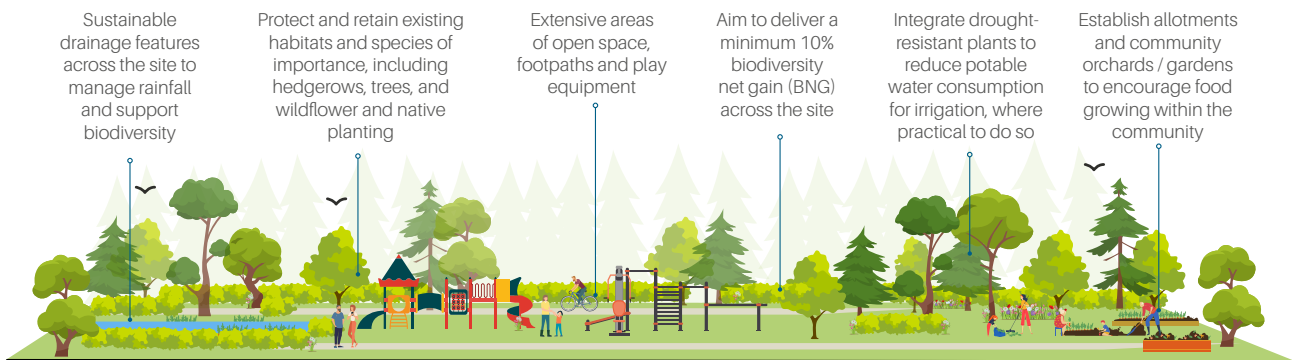
Sustainability Benefits of Development at Land West of Turners Hill Road and North of Huntsland, including land at Hurst Farm



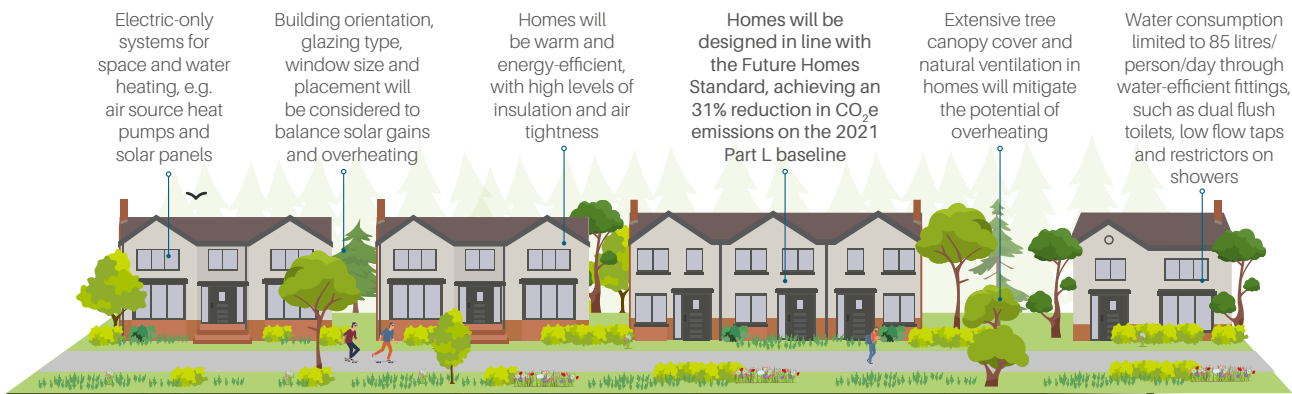
This infographic provides an overview of the sustainability benefits that could be delivered through the proposed development at the Land West of Turners Hill Road and North of Huntsland, including land at Hurst Farm, Crawley Down, Mid Sussex. The proposal will provide up to 230 homes, a 70 bed care home, a community facility, open space, internal access roads and footpaths, car parking including electric vehicle (EV) charging facilities, sustainable drainage systems and associated landscaping and infrastructure.

The development proposal expects to deliver a wide range of sustainability benefit that will contribute positively to the local area and help lay the foundations for a thriving place.
