Reasons for comment:

Comments:	<p>I object to this Planning Permission In Principal Application for many reasons.</p> <p>The site is outside of the built up area boundary and is a wholly inappropriate location for housing.</p> <p>Access to the site is via Lodge Lane, which is a narrow, single, rural lane used by walkers, cyclists and horse riders to access the wider countryside.</p> <p>There are limited safe walking routes within the area, with extremely limited public transport thus creating heavy car dependence.</p> <p>This development would extend into the village open countryside,</p>
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harming landscape character and the site is part of the setting of the High Weald National Landscape, being very close to the High Weald AONB.

In the 2022 SHELAA sites, this was site 749, and was rejected at Stage 2 (c), the reasons for this remain valid.

Having been forced to accept an allocation of 200 new houses at Foxhole Farm, despite numerous valid objections, the Village does not want or need yet more.
