<p>Site vacant field on the east side of Fox Hill. Site at lower level than road by entrance gate. Site rises up in levels to east, where majority of site is in Lewes DC. Western field parcel with MSDC is level and laid to grass. Eastern field parcel within Mid Sussex also laid to grass.</p> <p>Watercourse running through site with existing single width bridge into western field parcel.</p> <p>Barn within site adjacent to road, timber elevations and plain tile roof. Brick wall running along boundary with road. Collection of outbuildings to east of Cleavewater.</p>

North:	<p>North of western field parcel is site than has planning permsison for development and is now cleared.</p> <p>North of western field parcel in Mid Sussex are open fields</p>

South:	Open fields to south
East:	Fields laid to grass, rise in levels to east into Lewes DC
West:	Western field parcel has open boundary with land associated with Cleavewater Farm New development on opposite side of road. Pavement on opposite side of road
