I have reviewed the Arboricultural Method Statement (AMS), Tree Protection Plans (TPP), and Arboricultural Impact Assessment (AIA), for this proposal. Whilst I note the trees on the southern boundary are protected by TPO, the ash (T2) is shown as being in very poor condition and its removal would likely be accepted. However, as it is protected by TPO, we would ask for a replacement tree. Is there adequate space in the site for a new tree? If so, could this be conditioned, please?

If the measures described in the AMS and TPP's are implemented, the trees at this location should be fully protected. Please condition adherence to the AIA, AMS and TPP's.
