Reasons for comment:

Comments: This development would cause danger on The Street. On Google Maps, the routes from - for example - Brighton, Crawley, Haywards Heath and Burgess Hill send the driver along Ryecroft Road and up a very narrow bottleneck on The Street before Cherry Lane with no proper pavement. Villagers, including children, use this path frequently. Then, the driver would have to navigate a hairpin bend on Lodge Lane, which is also popular with walkers, horse riders and cyclists.

The field is beautiful and has a footpath running along it which is popular with walkers. It is rural and unspoilt, and cannot be

considered to be "in-fill".

Bolney has incredibly limited facilities so this development is not sustainable. Residents will be reliant on private cars.
