We have 3 bays for 6 houses plus inadequate parking outside the back , often we need to park across the road next to the site or down the road which isn't ideal with 2 children and is dangerous

If we can get assurances then we will be happy, such as :

Dedicated residents parking whilst works are going on, such as a

temporary permit or no works vehicles/church members parking on the road

The road is already congested enough as it is with traffic, so we would need assurances that no works vehicles or non resident vehicles will be blocking any access at any time and all access is kept inside the site

If these houses are built, we want a permit to be able to park on site in a place where we can leave our car permanently without fear of any fines, such as a parking permit. We don't want the already congested area to get worse. We would like this for residents who live in the adjacent houses + visitors if needs be.
