I would like to register my objection to the above planning application.

I am a resident of Kiln Road and we suffered a great deal during the construction of the Burleigh Wood Estate. Kiln Road road surface suffered considerable damage during the construction of the Burleigh Woods estate and has not been returned to its former condition. The junction priority with Burleigh Wood Estate, Kiln Road and Woodlands Drive was given to Burleigh Wood. This means that traffic speeds down Kiln Road and straight into the estate. Adding yet another junction within 20yards of that junction will only make things worse . Has it been investigated that Woodlands Close is wide enough and will be able to accept the large amount of traffic , especially when construction starts. If the road is built where the houses are to be demolished this will cause shining of car lights into the lounge of the neighbours opposite . Meanwhile if the pair of semis are demolished this will leave the lady living in the bungalow next to the on an island . She already has roads on three sides of her property. This will mean she is living on a roundabout. Originally her property was one of a pair of semis . Her attached neighbour's bungalow was demolished to give access to Burleigh Wood Estate. This caused considerable strain to her and why should she go through all this again. The back gardens of the properties on the side of the proposed construction are two tierand the construction is much higher , giving a possibility of a landslide. Also the ground floor windows of the new properties will overlook the second floor windows of the houses in Woodland Close.

Meanwhile I'm sure it's expected that families will move into the estate. There is no room at the local school . Already pupils are allocated places at other locations and the parents are responsible for transporting them. Also it is will known that the local doctors do not have capacity to cope with a minimum of a 100 patients
