I wish to object to the application ref: DM/25/1593 at woodlands Close and land to the north of Burliegh Lane Crawley Down for the following reasons.

The access road onto Woodlands Close is too close to the crossroad. Extra volume of traffic,= air pollution, head lights straight into no. 8A & 8b = light pollution.

No.13 left with a busy road on both sides of the property.

This new junction would result in visitors and deliveries being unable to park outside their properties.

The demolition of no.9 & 11 and the new access would be a significant loss to the appearance and be an overwhelming impact with increased noise and disturbances to residents on this end of the Close .

Six of these properties are occupied by people who moved in when they were new! Now hoping for peace watching the birds beautiful mature trees and the natural wildlife and the end of their lives in peace please.

A close usually has one entrance woodlands close as it did in 1962 , it now has two plus a dangerous crossroads an extra junction would be ONE TOO MANY!

This site has 4 Substantial pillisterd gateways exiting onto Burliegh lane for 4 plots in keeping with the surroundings. 48 dwellings on this site is over development and detrimental to the surrounding area.

The village has not got the infrastructure to provide new residents with the lifestyle that living in a VILLAGE should be! ie doctors, school, post office, sports facilities, and social venues.
