Summary

Further to our response dated 26th September 2025, we have reviewed the decision notice for DM/23/2687 and note that the following conditions require submission of the specified documents:

- Condition 18: details of a hard and soft landscaping scheme

- Condition 20: a Biodiversity Enhancement Layout
- Condition 21: a lighting scheme for biodiversity

In addition, Condition 19 requires compliance with the LPA Ecological Response (David Archer Associates, November 2023) and Preliminary Ecological Appraisal (David Archer Associates, April 2023).

Condition 18:

We have reviewed the Landscape Proposal Dwg No. 7731.01 Rev B (Trevor Bridge Associates Ltd., December 2025) submitted in order to discharge Condition 18 and would support the discharge of this condition at an ecological perspective.

Condition 20:

We have reviewed the Biodiversity Enhancement Layout (ROAVR Group, November 2025) submitted in order to discharge Condition 20. We note that the enhancements include the creation and gapping up of native hedgerows; the creation of two wildlife ponds; the erection of two bat boxes and two bird boxes per new dwelling, together with specifications, locations and erection heights; wildflower grassland; deadwood, log and brash piles; and hedgehog highways. The locations and specifications of the bird and bat boxes are also provided in the Landscape Proposal Dwg No. 7731.01 Rev B (Trevor Bridge Associates Ltd., December 2025). We would support the discharge of this condition.

Condition 21:

We have reviewed the sensitive lighting scheme in the Biodiversity Enhancement Layout (ROAVR Group, November 2025) submitted in order to discharge Condition 21 and would support the discharge of this condition at an ecological perspective.

Condition 19 – Compliance:

Subject to the LPA being satisfied works have followed the mitigation and enhancements set out within the LPA Ecological Response (David Archer Associates, November 2023) and Preliminary Ecological Appraisal (David Archer Associates, April 2023), we would support the discharge of Condition 19.
