Its also clear that some of my previous comments were prescient and accurate insofar that the latest updated application now shows use for what is still described as an agricultural storage "Barn" extended from not only said storage use but also to use for commercial office accommodation, i.e. making this a Class B1

development proposal rather than previously Class B8. This means much more intrusive noise, light, vehicular and air pollutions to at least mention the obvious impact, more so 24H7, than any dedicated storage warehouse might to the adjacent rural community. The accompanying email/letter also suggests that current storage requirements that precipitated the original Barn/Warehouse application may not now be met for existing tenants or those that might occupy the new commercial space, meaning that further development will be necessary, aggravating all aspects of impact previously commented upon.
