Further to the most recent consultation response from Highways (dated 02 May 2024), our transport consultant has been liaising directly with Ian Gledhill at WSCC. In response to the comments made, a Designers Response Report, including an RSA Decision Log (Appendix D of the report) that has been signed by both Ashley Helme and WSCC, has been finalised and is attached for formal submission as part of the planning application.

We have carefully reviewed the comments made by your conservation officer, in the consultation response of 01 May. The position of the applicant, and its heritage consultant is that it stands by the findings of the submitted Heritage Statement. Our heritage consultants remain of the view that Tythe Cottage and the Lindfield Conservation Area should appropriately be scoped out from further detailed assessment and stand by the rationale for taking this approach set out in the heritage statement. On this basis, the applicant does not intend to produce any supplementary information on heritage, at this stage.

In respect of the ecology response from Place Services, the additional survey work recommended in the Ecological Appraisal is being undertaken, although we are not in a position to submit a full suite of additional survey reports at this juncture. We further note the following comment in the response:

"We welcome the Biodiversity Net Gain Report in Appendix F of the Ecological Appraisal (FPCR Environment and Design Ltd., February 2024). However, please note that the Biodiversity metric Excel spreadsheet should also be submitted to the LPA so that the application can be fully reviewed"

The excel spreadsheet was submitted as part of the application (and is a requirement of validation). However, for the sake of completeness, we have attached a copy to this email. We'd be obliged if you could confirm receipt.

We are conscious that the deadline for the determination of the application is fast approaching (24th May 2024). We would thus welcome an open discussion with you on the likely officer position on this application.
